## CHESTERFIELD BOROUGH COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT) ORDER 2014

Chesterfield Borough Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the 1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of the Derbyshire County Council in accordance with section 39(3) of the 1984 Act and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Derbyshire Constabulary in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order:

#### PART 1 GENERAL

#### Commencement and Citation

1. This Order shall come into operation on the Unday of the hovening 2014 and may be cited as the Chesterfield Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) Order 2014.

#### Interpretation

In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the following meanings:

"1984 Act"

The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

"Advance Ticket"

A valid ticket purchased in advance from the Council for a period of use (e.g. day, week, month)

"Alternative Approved Method of Payment"

Park and Phone, payment by debit or credit card facilitated by on site or remote verification by, for example, card reader or mobile phone text or phone call or

#### decrementing card

"Bank Holiday" Christmas Day, Good Friday or a bank

holiday as defined in the Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971. The first of January (or the next available working day) and the first Monday of May shall be treated as if they were a Bank Holiday for

the purposes of this Order

"Charging Days" those days which are specified as

charging days in Schedule 1 (or if different) at each respective Parking

Place

"Charging Hours" the period within each Charging Day as

specified as charging hours in Schedule

1 (or if different) at each respective

Parking Place

"Council" Chesterfield Borough Council or its

successor authority

"Disabled Persons' Advance Ticket" An Advance Ticket only available to the

holder of a Disabled Persons' Badge

"Disabled Persons' Badge" a badge issued by any Local Authority in

accordance with the Local Authorities'
Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled

Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 or

a badge having effect under those regulations as if it were a Disabled

Person's Badge

"Expiry Time"

the time indicated on the Pay and
Display Ticket and is the time by which
the Vehicle must leave the Parking Place

"Goods Vehicle"

a Vehicle which is constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods or burden of any description, the overall height of which does not exceed 1.85 metres and the unladen weight of which does not exceed 2540 kilograms and is not drawing a trailer

"Large Goods Vehicle"

A large goods vehicle as defined in the Goods Vehicles (Licensing of Operators) Act 1995.with a relevant plated weight exceeding 16260 kilograms, or in the case of a vehicle which does not have a relevant plated weight, it has an unladen weight exceeding 5080 kilograms

"Loading/Unloading"

when a Vehicle is parked wholly in a
Parking Place or bay marked for that
purpose on site, for the purpose of
delivering or collecting goods or
merchandise or loading or unloading the
Vehicle at premises adjacent to the
Parking Place or bay and the Vehicle
does not park for more than twenty
minutes or such longer period as a duly
authorise

"Motor Car"

A mechanically propelled vehicle not being a motor cycle or an invalid carriage which is constructed itself to carry a load

or passengers and of which the weight unladen

- (a) if it is constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects is adapted to carry not more than seven passengers exclusive of the driver and is fitted with tyres of such type as may be specified in regulations made by the Secretary of State does not exceed 3050 kilograms or
- (b) if it is constructed or adapted for use for conveyance of goods or burden of any description does not exceed 3050 kilograms (or 3500 kilograms if the vehicle carries a container or containers for holding for the purpose of its propulsion any fuel which is wholly gaseous at 17.5 degrees Celsius under a pressure of 1.013 bar or plant and materials for producing such fuel) or
- (c) in a case falling within neither of paragraph (a) or (b) above does not exceed 2540 kilograms

as defined in Section 136 of the 1984 Act

a solo motorcycle only and excludes any motor cycle which has a side-car or trailer, or which has more than two

"Motor Cycle"

#### wheels

"Owner"

in relation to a Vehicle means the person who is recorded as the registered keeper by the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Agency on the date on which the Vehicle was parked in the Parking Place in question

"Park and Phone"

a method of payment of the parking charge involving registration of payment by phone or electronic means and, on first use, registration of the relevant registration number of the vehicle, location of the Parking Place, credit or debit card details or any such other details as the Council may from time to time require which is accepted by the Council as a valid method of payment for the relevant time of use of the Parking Place

"Parking Bay"

an area of a Parking Place, which is provided for the leaving of a Vehicle of a class specified and indicated by markings on the surface of the Parking Place or signed or otherwise indicated by signs in the Parking Place

"Parking Permit"

a valid parking permit for the relevant
Parking Place namely a season ticket,
contract permit, business permit, staff
permit, advance ticket, Scratch Card,
resident's permit, resident's parking disc
or other parking permit, pass or

dispensation of a type and design issued by the Council

"Parking Place"

an area of land specified in the First
Schedule (and indicated on the attached
location plans) provided by the Council
pursuant to Section 32(1) of the 1984 Act
for the purpose of parking of Vehicles
and not closed (in part or in whole) by a
notice erected on it by authority of the
Council

"Pay and Display Parking Place"

A Parking Place in which a Vehicle is required to display a Pay and Display Ticket

"Pay and Display Ticket Machine"

an apparatus of a type and design approved by the appropriate Minister for the purpose of the 1984 Act, being apparatus designed to indicate the time by a clock and to issue parking tickets which show that a payment has been made of an amount or for a period specified thereon and which specify the date and either the time of such payment, or the expiry time of the parking period for which payment has been made and (if the apparatus is designed to do so) the identity of the Vehicle and/or Parking Bay

"Pay and Display Ticket"

a ticket issued by a Ticket Machine located in the Parking Place in which the Vehicle has been parked or issued by a person nominated by the Council on

payment of a charge and valid for a parking period as advertised at that Parking Place

"Pay on Foot/Pay on Exit"

a Parking Place where:

- a ticket is issued by a ticket machine located at the entrance to a Parking Place and
- the ticket is retained by the Vehicle user and not displayed, and
- the relevant charge is paid as required at the Parking Place before returning to the vehicle or on exiting the Parking Place

"Penalty Charge"

a charge imposed by legislation in respect of parking contraventions that are subject to civil enforcement and has the same meaning as set out in the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007

"Relevant Information"

All the information (as appropriate to the appropriate Pay and Display Ticket or Parking Permit) contained on the front face of the Pay and Display Ticket or Parking Permit, such information may include (but not be limited to):

- the Council's name
- the Council's crooked spire logo
- type of Parking Permit
- name of Parking Place(s),
- area within Parking Place
- parking zone,
- time/date/place of purchase,

- time/date/period of validity
- expiry time/date
- pass or permit number
- vehicle registration number,
- parking bay
- issuer

"Relevant Position"

- (a) in respect of a Vehicle displaying avalid Disabled Person's Badge
  - (i) in the case of a

    Vehicle fitted with a dashboard or
    fascia panel, the badge is
    exhibited on the dashboard or
    fascia panel so that Part 1 (the
    front of the badge), is legible from
    outside the Vehicle; or
  - (ii) in the case of a Vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the Vehicle so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from outside the Vehicle;
- (b) in respect of a Vehicle displaying a Pay and Display Ticket or Parking Permit
  - (i) the Pay and Display Ticket, or Parking Permit is exhibited on the inside surface of the windscreen or in a conspicuous position on the dashboard or fascia panel so that it can be

easily seen and read from the outside of the front or side of the Vehicle

- (ii) in the case of a Vehicle that is not fitted with a transparent windscreen, the Pay and Display Ticket or Parking Permit is exhibited on the front of the Vehicle
- (iii) in the case of (i) and (ii) a
  Pay and Display Ticket or Parking
  Permit must be exhibited so that
  all of the front face of the ticket,
  permit or scratch card is facing
  forwards and shows the Relevant
  Information with the text the
  correct way up is clearly visible
  and can be easily seen and read:
- (c) in respect of a Vehicle displaying
  a Hackney Carriage Plate
  the plate must be affixed to
  the Vehicle in accordance with the
  instructions given within the
  licence as issued by the Council
- (d) for avoidance of any doubt
  Relevant Position shall not include
  any position of the Pay and
  Display Ticket or Parking Permit
  within or outside the Vehicle other
  than as set out in the definitions
  at (a) to (c) above

"Scale of Charges"

The scale of charges for the Parking
Place as set out in Schedule 3 to this
Order as amended by the Council from
time to time and advertised at each
Parking Place

"Scratch Card"

A parking permit of a type and design issued by the Council for the specified parking zone validated by scraping or scratching designated areas to reveal information used to identify correct date, month and year of use

"Vehicle"

any Motor Car, Motor Cycle, Goods Vehicle, or other mechanically propelled automobile (and "Vehicles" shall be interpreted accordingly)

"Zone"

A parking zone as specified by the Council by reference to specific Parking Places or areas of the borough as set out in Schedule 3 or as amended from time to time

- Except where the context requires otherwise, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article shall be construed as a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order
- 4. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, reenacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment
- 5. Unless the context otherwise requires, words denoting the singular shall include the plural and vice versa and words denoting persons shall include

either gender, bodies corporate, unincorporated associations and partnerships

6. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order

## PART 2 DESIGNATION AND USE OF PARKING PLACES

#### **Designation**

7. Each area of land or building specified by the accompanying plans and by name in the Schedule 1 may be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, as a place to park Vehicles of such classes, in such positions, on such days, during such hours, for such period and on payment of such charges as are set out in the Scale of Charges

#### Class and position of Vehicle etc

- 8. Where by notice or surface markings at a Parking Place, a Parking Place is described as available for:
  - Vehicles of a specified class or
  - Vehicle occupants of a specified class (for example, but not limiting the extent or interpretation of this Article, parent and child) or
  - Vehicles to be parked in a specified location,

no person shall cause or permit a Vehicle to be parked in that Parking Place or in any Parking Bay within the Parking Place:

- (i) unless the Vehicle or the Vehicle occupants (as appropriate) is/are of the specified class
- (ii) beyond the Parking Bay markings
- (iii) in a position other than that specified or
- (iv) for a purpose other than provided for in this Order.

#### Classes of Vehicle

9. No person shall cause or permit a Vehicle to be parked in a Parking Bay unless it is a Vehicle of a class specifically described in this Order, or by notice or surface markings at a Parking Place, as permitted to park in that Parking Bay

#### Disabled person's parking bays

10. No person shall cause or permit a Vehicle to be parked in a Parking Bay marked for disabled persons unless the Vehicle displays a valid Disabled Person's Badge in the Relevant Position and immediately before or immediately after the act of parking the Vehicle has been or is about to be used by the person(s) in respect of whom the Disabled Person's Badge has been issued

#### Permit Parking Bays

11. No person shall cause or permit a Vehicle to park in a Parking Place or Parking Bay indicated by notice or surface markings for permit holders unless the Vehicle is displaying a Parking Permit valid for that time and that Parking Place or Parking Bay (as appropriate)

#### Taxi Bays

12. No person shall cause or permit a Vehicle to be Parked in an area marked as a taxi bay unless the Vehicle displays in the relevant position a valid Hackney Carriage plate issued by the Council

#### Loading and Unloading Bays

13. No person shall cause or permit a Vehicle to park in any area marked as a loading bay unless the Vehicle is being used for the purpose of Loading/Unloading

#### Motor Cycle Parking

14. No person shall cause or permit a Vehicle to park in a Parking Place or Parking Bay marked for Motor Cycles unless the Vehicle is a Motor Cycle

#### No Parking Areas

- 14A. No person shall cause or permit a Vehicle to park in any position within a Parking Place other than that permitted under this Order and for avoidance of doubt (and not limiting the foregoing) no person shall cause or permit a Vehicle to park:
  - (i) in any area indicated in the Parking Place (whether by surface crosshatching or other markings and/or by sign or notice) as an area not available for parking of a Vehicle
  - (ii) on any grassed area within the Parking Place, unless clearly indicated by the Council by sign or notice as being available for parking of a Vehicle

#### Maximum Period of Stay

15. Where by notice on site, a Parking Place or any Parking Bay within the Parking Place is described as being in operation on specified days during specified hours or for a maximum period of stay, no person shall cause or permit a Vehicle to be parked in that Parking Place or in any Parking Bay within the Parking Place on any day during such hours or for any period other or longer than those specified

#### Period of no return

16. Where by notice on site, a Parking Place is described as having a period within which a Vehicle may not return, no person shall cause or permit a Vehicle to be parked again in that Parking Place on any day, during such hours within which the vehicle is excluded from waiting in the Parking place.

#### Power to close or suspend Parking Places

- 17. Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Council by notice, sign or barrier displayed in a Parking Place:
  - (i) from closing a Parking Place or any part thereof for any period; and/or

- (ii) from setting aside a Parking Place or any part or parts thereof on all days or on certain days or during certain parts of days for use only by particular Vehicles or organisations
- 18. Any person closing or suspending the use of a Parking Place or any part thereof shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that Parking Place or that part thereof a notice or traffic sign indicating that of that Parking Place or that part thereof is closed or the use is suspended and that Parking by Vehicles is prohibited
- 19. No person shall cause or permit a Vehicle to be Parked in a Parking Place or any part thereof during such periods that the Parking Place or that part thereof is closed or the use is suspended or during such period as there is in or adjacent thereto a notice or traffic sign indicating the closure or suspension placed by or on behalf of the Council

#### Sale of Goods

20. No person shall in a Parking Place without the express written permission of the Council, use a Vehicle in connection with the sale of any article, including the Vehicle itself, to any person in or near the Parking Place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of skill or services in any other capacity.

#### Parked with engine running

21. No person shall in a Parking Place continue to run the Vehicle engine when the Vehicle is in the Parking Bay and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the Vehicle in or to depart from the Parking Place

#### Parked causing an obstruction

22. No person shall in a Parking Place park the Vehicle in such a manner or place where it causes an obstruction to any other users of the Parking Place

#### PART 3

#### CHARGES FOR PARKING

#### **Payment**

23. No person shall cause or permit any Vehicle to be parked in a Parking Place without arranging for the appropriate charge (if any) to be paid in accordance with the Scale of Charges

#### Means of payment

24. The charges referred to in the preceding Article shall be payable in the manner as advertised at that Parking Place

#### Pay on Foot/Pay on Exit Parking Places

- 24A. The driver of a Vehicle using a Pay on Foot/Pay on Exit parking place shall:
  - (i) upon arriving at the Parking Place, take a ticket from the ticket machine to establish time of entry
  - (ii) on return to the Vehicle prior to exit from the Parking Place:
    - (a) pay at the pay on foot machine for the Parking Place the appropriate fee required in accordance with the scale of current charges as advertised at that Parking Place and take the ticket issued
    - (b) within any period of grace advertised on site proceed with the Vehicle to the exit point for the Parking Place
    - (c) insert the ticket into the machine at the exit barrier to enable exit from the Parking Place
    - or pay the attendant on duty, or a person nominated by the Council at the exit point, a parking fee at the level of charge and for the period required in accordance with the Scale of Charges
  - (iii) (in the event that on return to the Vehicle prior to exit from the Parking Place the ticket referred to in (i) is not available to insert into the machine) contact the parking controller by means of the intercom at the Pay on Foot/Pay on Exit machine who will arrange for a payment to be made in accordance with the Scale of Charges for the Charging Hours

for the whole day until the time of departure and then shall complete the actions set out in Clause 24A (ii) (with the exception of sub-clause (a)) above

#### Pay and Display Parking Places

- 25. The person in charge of a Vehicle, upon parking the Vehicle in a Parking Bay, shall immediately
  - (i) arrange for the purchase of a Pay and Display Ticket from a Pay and Display Ticket Machine situated in that Parking Place at the level of charge and for the period required in accordance with the scale of current charges as advertised at that Parking Place, or
  - (ii) make arrangements to pay the appropriate fee through an Alternative Approved Method of Payment (if available) at the level of daily charge and for the period required in accordance with the scale of charges as advertised at that Parking Place

#### Display of Pay and Display Ticket

- 26. Save where payment has been made by an Alternative Approved Method of Payment (if available), once a Vehicle has been parked within a Pay and Display Parking Place the person in charge of the Vehicle shall:
  - ensure that a valid Pay and Display Ticket has been obtained to cover the entire period that the Vehicle is parked in the Parking Place and is displayed at all times the Vehicle is parked, and
  - (ii) display the valid Pay and Display Ticket the Relevant Position on the Vehicle in respect of which it was issued so that it shows the Relevant Information

#### Validity of Pay and Display Tickets

27. A Pay and Display Ticket is not transferable from one Vehicle to another and on transfer the Pay and Display Ticket ceases to be valid

28. A Pay and Display Ticket is valid only in the Parking Place in which it was issued. This is defined by the reference code of the Ticket Machine located in that Parking Place printed on the Pay and Display Ticket

#### Pay and Display Parking Places - Expiry of parking period

- 29. The expiry of the period for which the appropriate charge has been paid shall be:
  - (i) where a Pay and Display Ticket has been purchased, when the time shown on the clock of the issuing Ticket Machine is later than the Expiry Time shown on the Pay and Display Ticket displayed, or
  - (ii) where an Alternative Approved Method of Payment has been used, the period for which payment has been made and recorded has been exceeded

#### Pay and Display Parking Places - No Pay and Display Ticket displayed

- 30. Save where payment has been made by an Alternative Approved Method of Payment (if available), If at any time while a Vehicle is parked in a Pay and Display Parking Place no Pay and Display Ticket is displayed on that Vehicle in the Relevant Position and in accordance with the provisions of this order, it shall be deemed that the charge has not been paid
- 31. If at the time when a Vehicle is parked during the Charging Hours in a Parking Place and the nearest Ticket Machine in that Parking Place is out of order, then a ticket shall be obtained from another Ticket Machine within the same Parking Place (where provided) or as directed on site
- 32. Where no valid Pay and Display Ticket can be obtained from a Ticket Machine within a Parking Place, Vehicles may be parked in a Parking Place but may not be parked for longer than the maximum period of parking in that Parking Place as advertised at the Parking Place

#### **Parking Permits**

- 33. Parking Permits are available from the Council at an appropriate fee for a Vehicle of a specific class and for a specific Parking Place and subject to conditions determined by the Council
- 34. The driver of the Vehicle shall abide by the terms stipulated by the Council for the use of the Parking Permit
- 35. A Parking Permit is only valid in the Parking Place in respect of which it was issued, for the Vehicle in respect of which it was issued and up to the date of expiry shown on the Parking Permit
- 36. A Parking Permit remains the property of the Council and must be surrendered on request. In such instances any refund of fee paid will be provided in accordance with the Council's policies and subject to Clause 39

#### **Display of Parking Permit**

37. Save where payment has been made by an Alternative Approved Method of Payment (if available), a Parking Permit shall be displayed in the Relevant Position on the Vehicle in respect of which it was issued at all times during which the Vehicle is parked in the Parking Place

#### Replacement Parking Permits

38. Damaged or lost Parking Permits will be replaced on application to the Council and on payment of an administration fee in accordance with Council policies. The damaged or lost Parking Permit will then become immediately invalid. For the purposes of this clause the definition of Parking Permit shall not include a Scratch Card

#### Surrender of Parking Permit

39. The holder of a Parking Permit may, on surrendering the Parking Permit, be entitled to a refund based upon the Council policy in place at that time and at the Council's unfettered discretion.

#### Scratch Cards

#### 39A A Scratch Card

- (i) shall be displayed in the Relevant Position on the Vehicle in respect of which it was issued at all times during which the Vehicle is parked in the Parking Place
- (ii) is valid only in the Parking Place for which it was issued.This is defined by the parking zone and Parking Places(s) printed on the Scratch Card
- (iii) is valid only if prior to display the designated areas on the Scratch Card are scratched or scraped to reveal information used to identify year, month and date of use
- (iv) is not valid if more than one date, month or year are revealed
- (v) must be used in accordance with the terms set out on the Scratch Card

#### Restriction on removal

40. When a Pay and Display Ticket or Parking Permit has been exhibited on a Vehicle in the Relevant Position no person shall remove the Pay and Display Ticket or Parking Permit from the Vehicle until the Vehicle is removed from the Parking Place

### PART 4 EXEMPTIONS

#### **Exemption from Daily Charge**

- 41. No daily charge shall be payable in respect of
  - (i) [Not used]
  - (ii) a Motor Cycle; or
  - (iii) a Vehicle parked displaying in the Relevant Position a valid Parking Permit valid for that Parking Place

#### Absence of Ticket Machine

42. If at the time when a Vehicle is parked in a Parking Place during the charging hours there is no Ticket Machine at the Parking Place, or all the Ticket Machines at that Parking Place carry notices placed upon them by a person duly authorised by the Council indicating that they are out of order, the driver of that Vehicle shall be exempt from purchasing a Pay and Display Ticket

#### Payment by Alternative Approved Method of Payment

43. Where arrangements to pay the Daily Charge have been successfully made through an Alternative Approved Method of Payment and no Pay and Display Ticket is produced, or no Parking Permit made available, by following the process, the driver of a vehicle shall be exempt from the requirement to display such a ticket

#### PART 5

#### RELOCATION, REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF VEHICLES

#### **Emergencies**

44. A person authorised by the Council or a Police Constable in uniform may, using such measures as are appropriate, move or cause to be moved in the case of an emergency to any place he/she thinks fit, any Vehicle parked in a Parking Place

#### Contraventions in suspended Parking Place

45. A person authorised by the Council may, using such measures as are appropriate, move or cause to be moved to any place he/she thinks fit, any Vehicle parked in a Parking Place which has been closed or suspended in whole or in part by the Council and the cost of movement or removal and safe keeping shall be the liability of the Vehicle owner

#### Safe keeping

46. Any person removing a Vehicle from a Parking Place under the provisions of this Order shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary to provide for the safe keeping of the Vehicle

#### Disposal of a Vehicle abandoned in a Parking Place

47. The Council may sell or otherwise dispose of, in accordance with current legislation, a Vehicle which has been, or could at any time be, removed from a Parking Place if the Vehicle appears to have been abandoned

## PART 6 CONTRAVENTION AND PENALTY CHARGE

#### Contravention

- 48. Save for the provisions in Part 7, if a Vehicle is parked in a Parking Place without complying with the requirements of this Order, a contravention shall have occurred and a Penalty Charge shall be payable and/or the vehicle may be removed from the location.
- Where a contravention has occurred a notice of the Penalty Charge shall be served by affixing it to the Vehicle or giving it to the person appearing to be in charge of the Vehicle

#### Restriction on removal of notices

- 49. A notice of the Penalty Charge fixed to a Vehicle in accordance with this Order shall not be removed or interfered with except by or under the authority of:
  - (i) the Owner, or person in charge of, the Vehicle;
  - (ii) the Council for the Parking Place in which the Vehicle was found.

#### Indications as Evidence

The particulars given in the notice of the Penalty Charge attached to a Vehicle in accordance with this Order shall be treated as evidence in any proceedings relating to failure to pay such Penalty Charge.

#### PART 7

#### LIABILITY AND OTHER PROVISIONS

#### Liability

51. The Council accepts no liability for the loss or damage to Vehicles or other property left in any of the Parking Places to which this Order applies save for that arising from the negligence of the Council

#### <u>Validity</u>

52. If a court, the Department for Transport, the Traffic Penalty Tribunal or the Traffic Enforcement Centre declares any part of this Order to be invalid or unenforceable, such declaration shall not invalidate the remainder of the Order

#### **Driving within a Parking Place**

- 53. Where in a Parking Place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of
  - (i) indicating the entrance to or exit from the Parking Place, or
  - (ii) indicating that a Vehicle using the Parking Place shall proceed in a specified direction within the Parking Place

any person who drives or permits to be driven any Vehicle

- (i) so that it enters the Parking Place otherwise than by an entrance or leaves the Parking Place otherwise than by an exit, so indicated, or
- (ii) in a direction other than so specified

shall be liable to prosecution

Any person who, without with the permission of a person authorised by the Council in that behalf, drives or permits to be driven any Vehicle in a Parking Place for any purpose other than the purpose of leaving that Vehicle in the Parking Place in accordance with the provisions of this

Order or for the purpose of departing from the Parking Place shall be liable to prosecution

#### Wilful damage

55. [Not Used]

#### Domestic purposes

- 56. Any person who uses any part of the Parking Place or any Vehicle parked in a Parking Place
  - (i) for sleeping or camping or cooking, or
  - (ii) for the purpose of servicing or washing any Vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable the Vehicle to depart from the Parking Place

shall be liable to prosecution.

#### **Behaviour**

- 57. Any person who wilfully sounds any horn or any other similar instrument on a Vehicle except when about to change the position of the Vehicle in or to depart from the Parking Place shall be liable to prosecution
- Any person who in a Parking Place shouts or otherwise or otherwise makes any loud noise to the disturbance or annoyance of users of the Parking Place or residents or premises in the neighbourhood shall be liable to prosecution
- 59. Any person who in a Parking Place uses any threatening, abusive or insulting language, gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear or so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned shall be liable to prosecution

#### Other activities

- 60. Any person who in a Parking Place
  - (i) erects or causes or permits to be erected any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure without the written consent of the Council, or
  - (ii) lights or causes to be lit any fire
  - (iii) takes part in any game or activity (without authority of the Council)
  - (iv) distributes, or places on a vehicle, any advertising material

shall be liable to prosecution

#### PART 8

#### **REVOCATIONS**

#### Revocations

The order made by the Council set out in Schedule 2 and any other orders and regulations of whatever nature relating to off-street Parking Places within the area of the Council made before the introduction of this Order are revoked
